Reflections on the Scripture Passage Acts 17: 22-31

- Paul took time to look and learn about the cultural context
- Paul based his communication on their culture
- He did not degenerate their idolatry but offered something better
- He spoke about a God who was knowable (rather than just known about)
- God was present in the midst of all their idolatrous clutter - so close but unseen. He just needs to be discovered.
- He spoke of a God who was reaching out - wanting to be known.
- He spoke about our ultimate accountability to God
- It took courage to stand in the midst of idolatry and philosophers and rationally present the gospel. We need to remember that the gospel is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes (Romans 1:16)
